The pool of 8th graders is a good place to start building the HS. Not sure HS students understand the impact of badmouthing the HS to the 8th graders. They don't understand enrollment and revenue linkage.

Mr. Anthony

Student Council Committee is the place to fix HS.

Ms. Peterson

Has ideas for getting HS students and teachers to take ownership of the HS PR issue, need creative ways to address it, and have students implement their solutions.

Michelle

Parents should present to parents. Students and teachers present to the school (staff).

Issue

Sharing specials (music, art, p.e.) schedule conflicts spilling over into MS and ES. HS gets priority due to graduation requirement.

Ms. Hannigan

HS schedule is done first, then MS, then ES. Kiowa schedule looks a lot like ours, like Hugo's.

Is the HS/MS schedule conflict due to teacher availability or facility scarcity? If other schools manage schedule conflicts with few teachers, can one rule out a teacher availability problem? Doesn't it have to then be a facility availability issue?

Heard that ES teachers can be intimidated by HS students.

These adults are not used to working with teenagers as a group.

Ms. Borden

HS student behavior is a parent problem.

Perhaps the entire school community needs a few lessons about how to handle themselves in crowded situations.

Create situations for multiple age groups to personally interact.

ES students also have an attitude toward HS students. Michelle – there's a negative aura in the school. It won't be a quick fix.

Question posed to Ms. Hannigan

Can't the teachers be directed by administration to integrate the school and the students across age groups? Not answered.

General kumbaya discussion. Student email, texting, direct contact, not sure context of this.

Social committee discussion.

Blue sky ideas about HS social events. Borden wants dad's involved. Money collecting/holding needs work.

Can we get a pro-forma schedule solution from Pike's Peak to see what one would look like?

Michelle and Mr. Borden (student) not fans of on-line courses. On-line ed is a fact of life, and a growing one.

LA currently uses "Colorado On-line Academy" Need a good computer. Why can't we use currently idle laptops? See site for course offerings and schedule.

Current exit survey results?

Will more on-line classes save (keep at LA) some currently potential student losses? Probably not.

C. Borden (HS student)

We have a lack of class choices and students are treated like they're in 6th grade.

Discussion of electives, full vs. part time, funding confusion, teleconferencing, distance learning, Michelle and Mr. Anthony to look into providers and required computer tech.

2 large classes of 7th graders coming up, what is FPC role for MS issues? Need to focus more on math and science. STEM school.

We can offer pre-calc next year. We can build incrementally and move in the right direction.

LA HS needs differentiation and a market niche.
